



CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Be respectful of the locations where you film and members of the public. Leave every place in the exact condition you found it (or better)! Make sure to pack out any of your trash. It is a privilege to get to film in our city and we want to be able to do this for years to come!
2. Treat any filming equipment used or borrowed carefully and do not damage it.
3. Be respectful of each other and everyone's ideas. Be courteous and polite in all of your actions. Working as a team means collaborating and acknowledging that each person has a say in your film.
4. Hate speech, bullying, intimidation, or acts of aggression or violence toward others will not be tolerated.
5. You must get verbal consent before hugging, touching, photographing anyone, or filming any intimacy.
6. Safety is of the utmost importance. Do not engage in activity that would put you, your crew members, or actors at risk of harm or injury. Do not engage in illegal activity.

The purpose of the festival is to learn, get experience on a film set, make art, have fun, and build community. Keep this in mind as you go about making your films!
